The Mauro Veglio 2018 Barolo Paiagallo shows a point of brightness that gives this wine an especially etched or linear performance. Fruit comes from 40-year-old vines and skin maceration times are slightly longer (lasting from 22 to 25 days), giving the wine more power. It wraps smoothly and completely over the palate, imparting sweet fruit, wild rose, blood orange and grilled herb along the way. Aged in large oak casks, the Paiagallo is tight and structured at this young stage, and the wine will loosen up and soften with more time in the bottle. Production is 4,000 bottles.

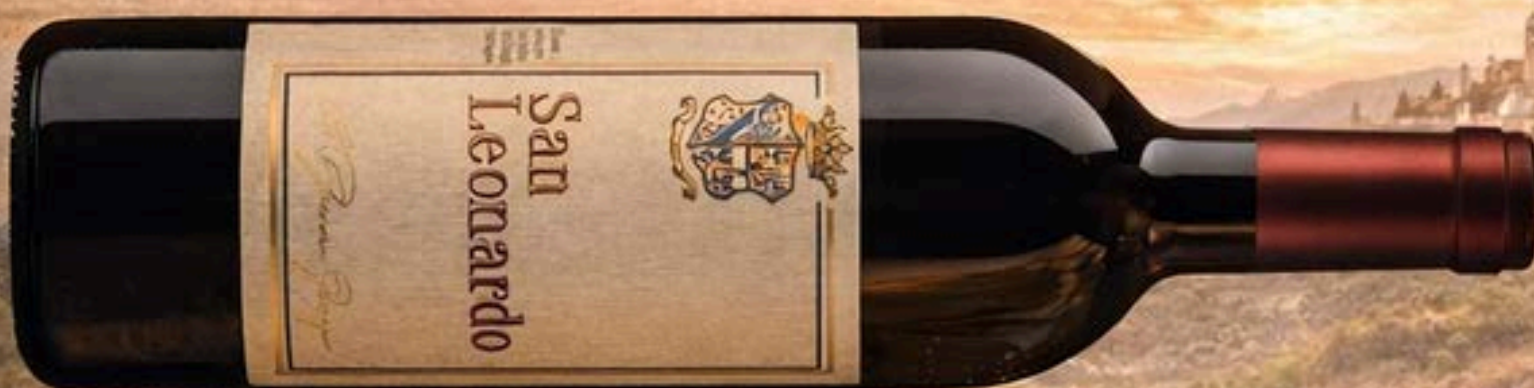

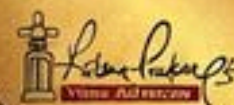

Magnum. Big, ripe and rather bold. This wine from the heatwave vintage doesn't have the subtlety of many other vintages but it has admirable and rather unexpected freshness. Carlo apparently decided to stop de-leafing and performing a green harvest this year to prevent sunburn and overripeness of too small a crop. The Carmenère element seems quite strong in this wine. If I tasted it in isolation I would probably be more impressed, but it doesn't stand up so well in comparison with less challenging vintages.

2010 was a very dry vintage of exceptional quality, producing incredibly structured and complex wines that are a little formidable when young but should age incredibly. Deep garnet-purple colored, the nose of the 2010 Les Forts de Latour is broody with subtle notes of licorice, tar, crushed black berries and plums with hints of spice cake and hoisin. Full-bodied, firm and grainy with an impenetrable core of muscular fruit, it finishes with fantastic persistence. Give it 5-7 years at least, and then it may well outlive the 1970 Les Forts that I recently tasted with Latour's CEO, Frédéric Engerer!

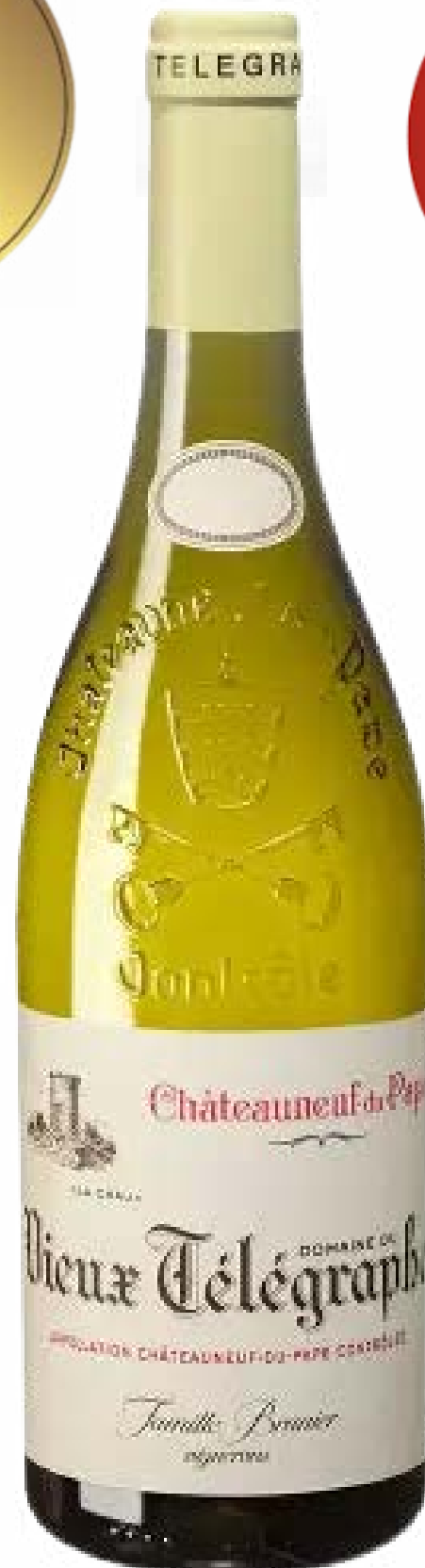

A blend of 40% Clairette and 30% each Grenache Blanc and Roussanne, from vines in la Crau that average 50 years old, the 2018 Chateauneuf du Pape Blanc continues the excellent run for this wine. It's zesty, lime-ridden and briny on the nose, medium to full-bodied and a bit silky on the palate, but it's so fresh, citrusy and vibrant on the finish that it comes across as crisp and refreshing. I've been gradually extending the drinking windows on white Châteauneufs, as I become convinced that many of them age better than I've given them credit for in the past. This one should drink well for at least 5-6 years.

VINIFICATION & AGEING

Harvest: manual harvest followed by a manual sorting

Vinification: after a pneumatic pressing of the whole grapes and twelve hours of static clarification without the use of enzymes, the berries start their alcoholic fermentation at a low temperature.

Ageing: in new oak barrels (30%) as well as in oak barrels of one to four years, on its lees with regular push downs

Time of ageing: 17 months in oak barrel then 1 month in a tank

TASTING

Nose of citrus, hazelnuts and brioche. Well-rounded, gourmet and fruity palate with a nice saline freshness typical of the village.

Food & wine pairings: Grilled scallops, lobster stew and risotto

Cellaring potential: from 5 to 10 years
