Few names in Bordeaux carry the romance and history of Château Calon Ségur, one of the oldest estates in Saint-Estèphe, with origins dating back to the 12th century.

The château became legendary under the Marquis Nicolas-Alexandre de Ségur, the famed “Prince of Vines,” who also owned Lafite and Latour, yet famously declared: *“I make wine at Lafite and Latour, but my heart is at Calon.”*

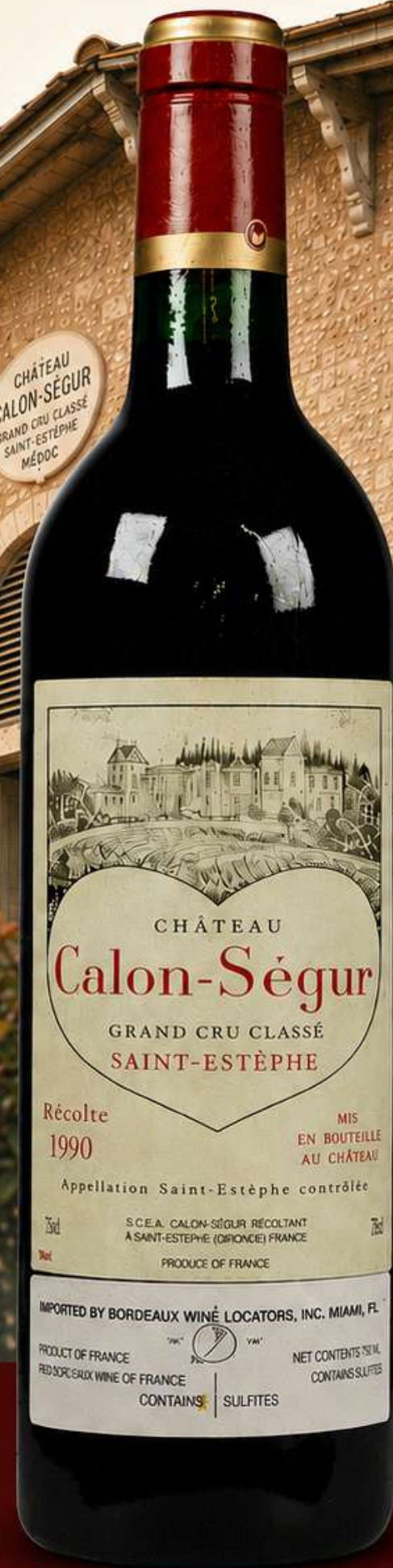
